



## The Kantha Bopha Children's Hospitals of Cambodia on July 11, 2011

On July 11, on a day as any other day around here, and without any declared epidemic, the hospital activity at Kantha Bopha has been enormous, nevertheless, even over night. **2179 severely sick children were hospitalized.**

### Activity in Phnom Penh:

Sick children treated at the out patient facilities:	2410
<b>Hospital admissions of severely sick children:</b>	<b>325 (71 over night)</b>
Surgical procedures:	29 (4 over night)
Discharge of hospitalized children:	315

### Activity in Siem Reap Angkor:

Sick children treated at the out patient facilities:	1613
<b>Hospital admissions of severely sick children:</b>	<b>261 (29 over night)</b>
Surgical procedures:	24 (2 over night)
Deliveries at the maternity clinic:	48 (28 over night)
Discharge of hospitalized children:	283

**A total of 151 severely sick children required immediate admission to the intensive care units.** They would not have survived, not even during the 24 hours while the admissions took place. All this occurred on July 11, on a day like any other day.

80% of all hospitalized children have no chance at least within the 4 months following the hospitalization.

All treatment is free for all patients. 90% of the patients families have a daily income of 0,5 USD. It is a huge misery.

On July 11 **178 children suffering from severe Hemorrhagic Dengue Fever** are hospitalized. **53 cases of Meningitis, 45 cases of Encephalitis.**
